Placer Democrats Highlight Election Year With 2007 Calendar *Congressional, Assembly Campaigns Featured in Commemorative Work*

AUBURN, CA – In recognition that the 2006 mid-term election was one of the finest democratic efforts in recent Gold County history, the Placer County Democratic Central Committee is issuing a 2007 commemorative calendar, "*We the ... People ... Before Politics.*" The calendar will feature photos from throughout the past year highlighting the people who have contributed to the rise of Placer County Democratic politics in 2006.

Highlighted in the calendar is the 4th Congressional race, which pitted Roseville Democrat Charlie Brown against longtime Republican incumbent John Doolittle, and the California's State Assembly Fourth District race, which featured Auburn Democrat Rob Haswell and Republican Ted Gaines vying for an open seat. Doolittle narrowly defeated Brown in what by all accounts was the congressman's toughest reelection fight ever.

The Calendar will cost \$20 with proceeds being split between the PCDCC and the Child Abuse Prevention Council (CAPC) of Placer County. Those interested in ordering a *We the ... People ...
